the same quality at much lower prices at the supermarket near our house.


Yuka: I see. Thanks for your advice. I'm glad we came here together.

The Pacific Crest *Trail (PCT) is one of the most famous long-distance hiking trails in the world. It starts in California at the border with Mexico. The trail goes north through California, Oregon, and Washington, and ends at the border with Canada. The trail crosses many national parks, forests, and mountains, including the *Sierra Nevadas and the *Cascades. Some sections are high in the mountains, while others go through dry deserts or thick forests. Hikers can see many types of plants and animals, making it a great place for nature lovers.

The Pacific Crest Trail is very long, about 4,265 kilometers in total. Because it is so long, it takes a lot of time and effort to walk the entire trail. The PCT crosses different climates, so hikers need to be prepared for both hot desert sun and cold mountain weather.


